

This half term in N Rosen, we will be exploring...

Literacy

In Literacy, we will be sharing two key texts, 'Percy the Park keeper: Hide and Seek' and 'WOW! said the Owl'. We will continue to give meaning to marks on our drawings and begin to make marks that stand for our name, as well as recognising our name with visual support. We will practise writing the first letter of our






name through sensory provision and large-scale mark-making. We will also continue to share a variety of stories, songs and rhymes to support our developing phonological awareness and our growing knowledge of the concepts about print.

Maths

In Maths, we will be exploring counting by ordering number names, specifically "I, 2, 3", through play and every day routines. We will begin practising recognising 3



objects without counting them (subitising) and focusing on where we can see 1, 2, 3. We will develop our



knowledge of pattern by confidently joining in with repeats and saying what will happen next. We will also continue to explore shape by arranging blocks in chosen positions and describing our constructions with positional language such as in, out, under, on top, in front, behind.

'If You Go Down to the Woods Today...'

This half term, our topic is 'If You Go Down to the Woods Today...'. Throughout the topic, we will be exploring the season Autumn and linking this to our natural environment by identifying woodland features, animals and changes in the weather. In 'Learn and Explore Time', we will be using our senses to investigate natural resources, go on an Autumn walk to the local park and create artwork linked to Autumn festivals, such as Bonfire Night and Remembrance Day.



We will continue to build familiar relationships with our key workers, new friends and explore the wider environment of the school. We will be sharing more details about our experiences, our homes and our families and identifying some similarities and differences between us.
