



This half term in N Rosen, we will be exploring...

Literacy

In Literacy, we will be sharing two key texts, 'Monkey and Me' and 'Rumble in

'Down in the Jungle'

This half term, our topic is Down in the Jungle. We are learning all about a jungle habitat; this includes what it looks like. which animals live there and where

jungles are in the world. We are also exploring what a zookeeper does and learning about how they take care of different animals. We will use our bodies and voices to take on the role of different animals too!

Maths

In Maths, we will revisit and extend our learning of one-toone correspondence with up to 3 objects. We will also introduce



the 'cardinal principle' which is the understanding that the last number said, is the total number of objects. We will explore the meaning of 'same' and 'different' as we enhance our construction skills. We will further develop our subitising skills by recognising up to 3 dots at once



without counting them. We will also revisit our learning on comparison by making collections, using the language 'more'. 'fewer'. 'same'.

Phonics

In Phonics, we will continue exploring aspects 1-7 of Phase I with a particular focus on aspects 4-6 (rhythm and rhyme, alliteration, voice



sounds). We will think about how when words rhyme, they have the same end sound. We will also recognise the initial sound of people/animals/objects, e.g., how 'snake' begins with a "ssss" sound. We will then be finding more objects beginning with the same sound.
