Reception Learning Spring 1

This half term in Reception, we have been exploring...

Literacy

In Literacy, we will be sharing 'The Naughty Bus' and 'Emergency' with the children as our main Literacy texts.

We will also share a variety of key texts, songs and rhymes.

We will be continuing to use our 'Fred Fingers' to spell CVC words (i.e., red) when labelling pictures and writing sentences using 'I am...' and 'It is a...'. We will be introducing the red word 'the' to enhance our sentencing writing (i.e., I am in the box).

Can your child write a CVC word to label something at home? Can your child write a simple sentence (see above), either about themselves or a character in a story?







Maths

In Maths, over the next half term we will be learning about numbers to 8. We will be exploring mass and capacity along with singing a variety of number songs and rhymes.

<u>Journeys</u>

This half term, our topic is Journeys. We will be drawing our own maps and following a route. We will encourage the children to explore the outdoors areas to create their own transport and maps working together to solve problems. We will be learning about winter; the changing seasons and we will go on a winter walk to the park. We will create our own observational drawings of transport and explore colour, texture and pattern.
