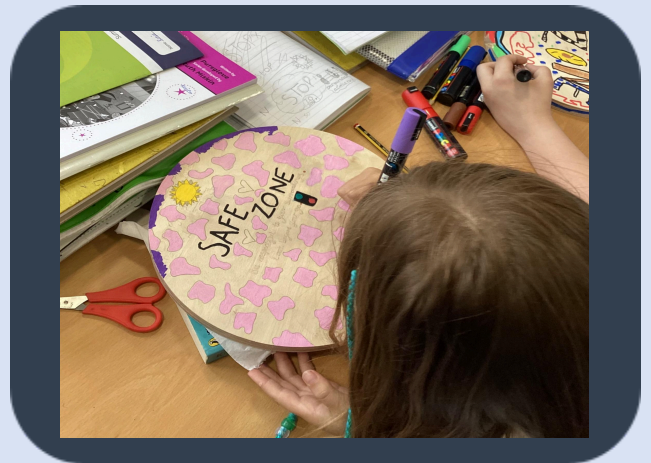
Nursery

Sports Day

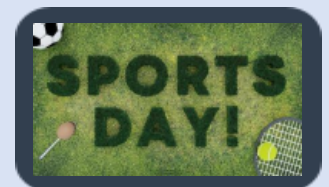
Parents and carers are welcome to attend our Sports Day on: **Wednesday 24th July OR Thursday 25th July** (depending on which year group your child is in - see below).
