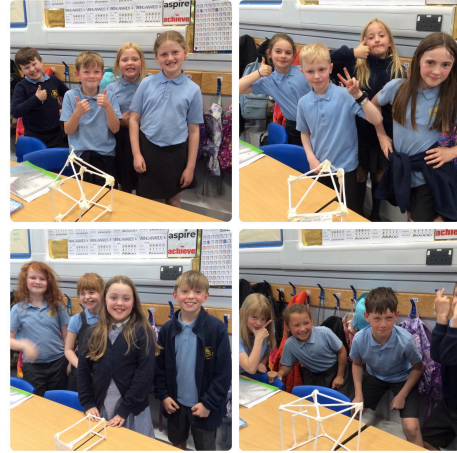
KS1
